## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.76027 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Menard County.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.76027 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$0.69957 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$0.76027 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Menard County from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Menard County may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Menard County is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 8, 2025 AT 9:00AM AT Menard County Commissioner's Courtroom, 206 East San Saba Avenue, Menard, Texas.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Menard County is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Menard County Commissioners of Menard County at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Menard County last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Menard County this year.
